AfriHost Internet Backbone based servers - far side scrubbing

- Commercial Bit-Defender Based Front Filter
 - Drops virus mails
 - 99% are forged addresses
 - Subject and Header Flags for SPAM
- Postfix Mail Servers
 - Whitelisted clients allowed else drop
 - Multiple DNSRBL black-lists, including local zone
 - Poor protocol (lack of HELO etc.), Non FQDN, no MX/A record, etc domains rejected
 - PostGrey Listing with 600 second retry
 - SpamAssassin Header Flags with score of 5 triggers Subject SPAM modification



Uplink

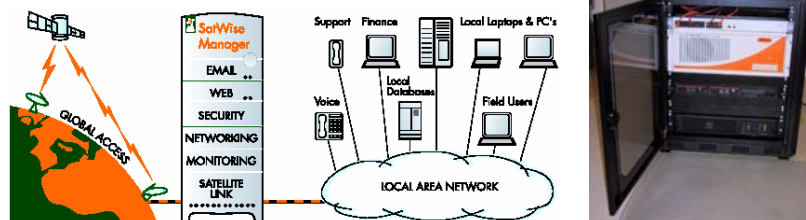
- Internet based mail relay
 - Protects from outgoing viruses
 - Moves delivery problems into high bandwidth territory
 - Trojan/virus mail targets
 - Destination domain on thin/unreliable link
- Ensure larger outgoing mails are sent out of prime time
- Use Dansguardian / Squid to protect bandwidth as well as inappropriate content



Protect the downstream site (proxy/dns/mail/filters)

SatWise:

- Provides total 'Internet in a box' end solution
- Fully manageable by local staff of whatever capability
- Remote management as required.



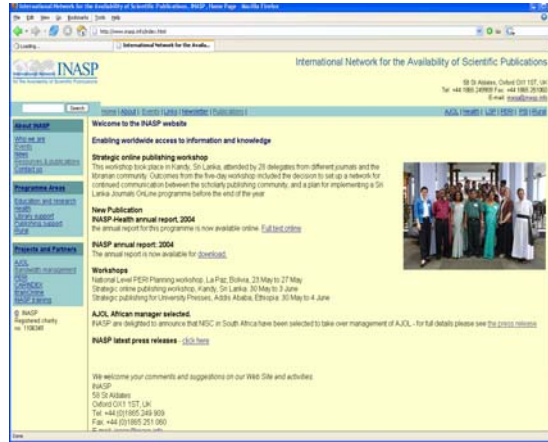
Filtering Results

- Between 10 and 25% of mail was virus
- 20% of mail was Spam from new sources
 - Option to drop/quarantine and not forward
- 30-40% of mail was SPAM from known sources
 - Just dropped
- Incidence of wildfire viruses dropped to a tenth – now solely carry-ins



Innovation in bandwidth – web scrubbing

- Working with AidWorld Cambridge to deliver usable web pages that minimise web traffic
- Used via proxy for ad infested sites
 - Hotmail
 - Yahoo
 - Google
 - etc
